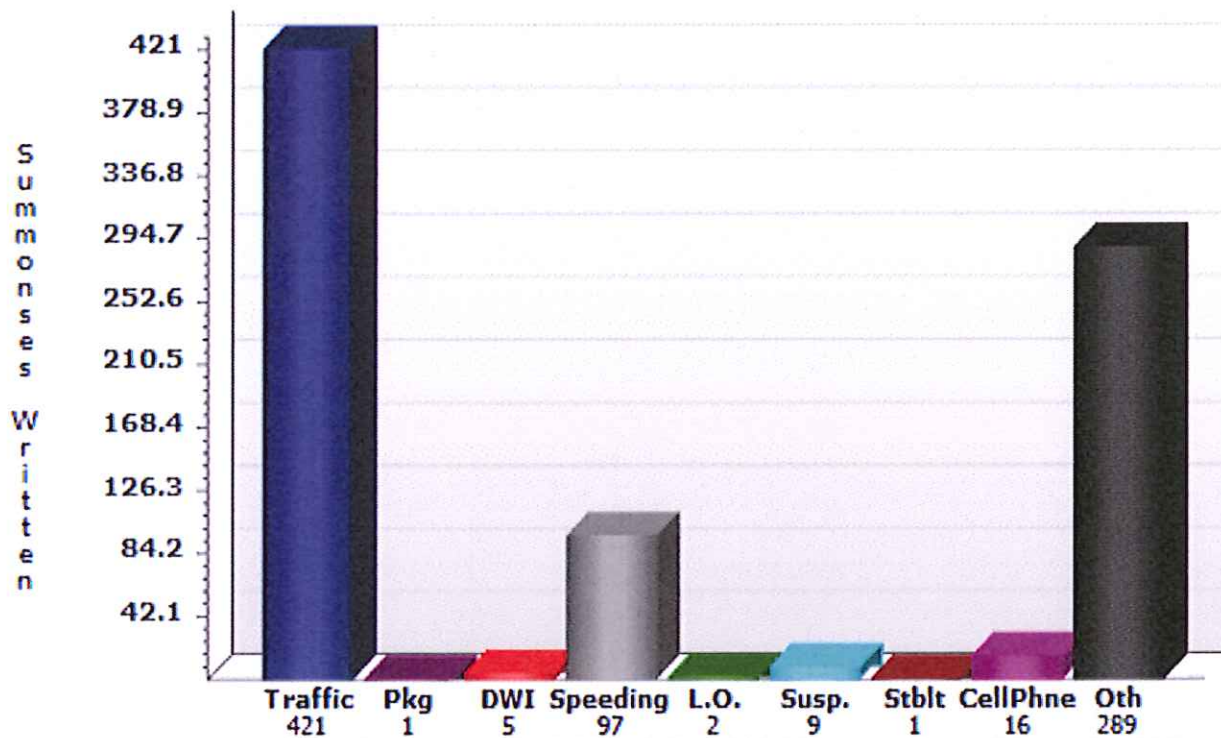
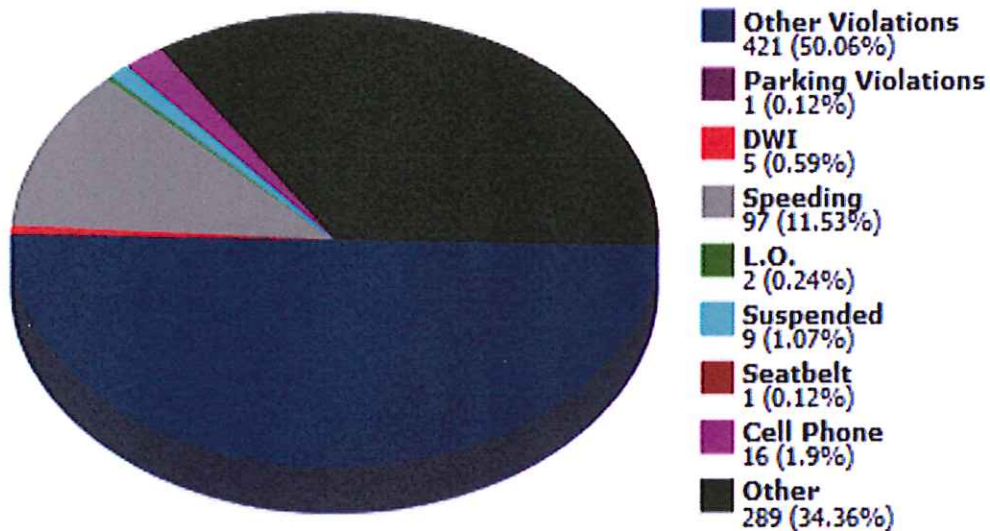

Summons Graphs for: August 2013



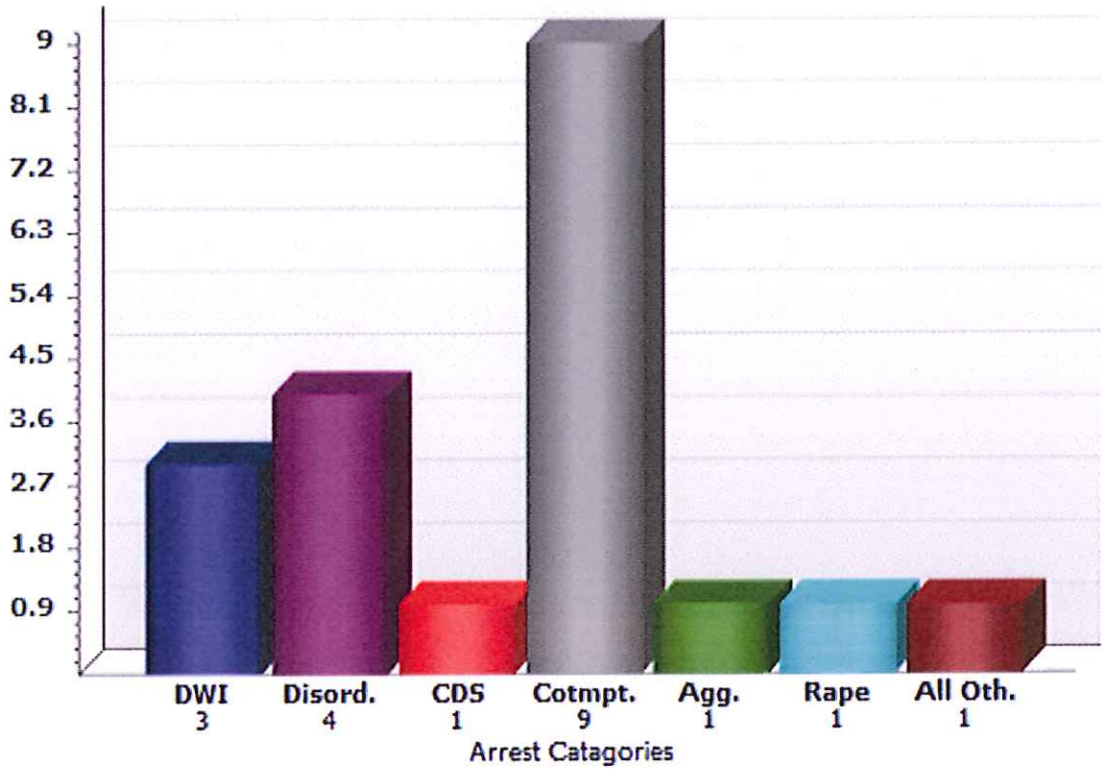
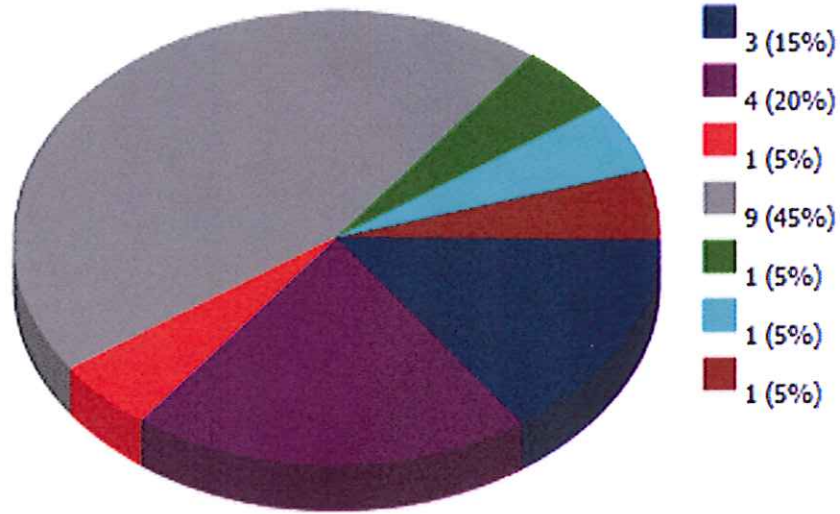
