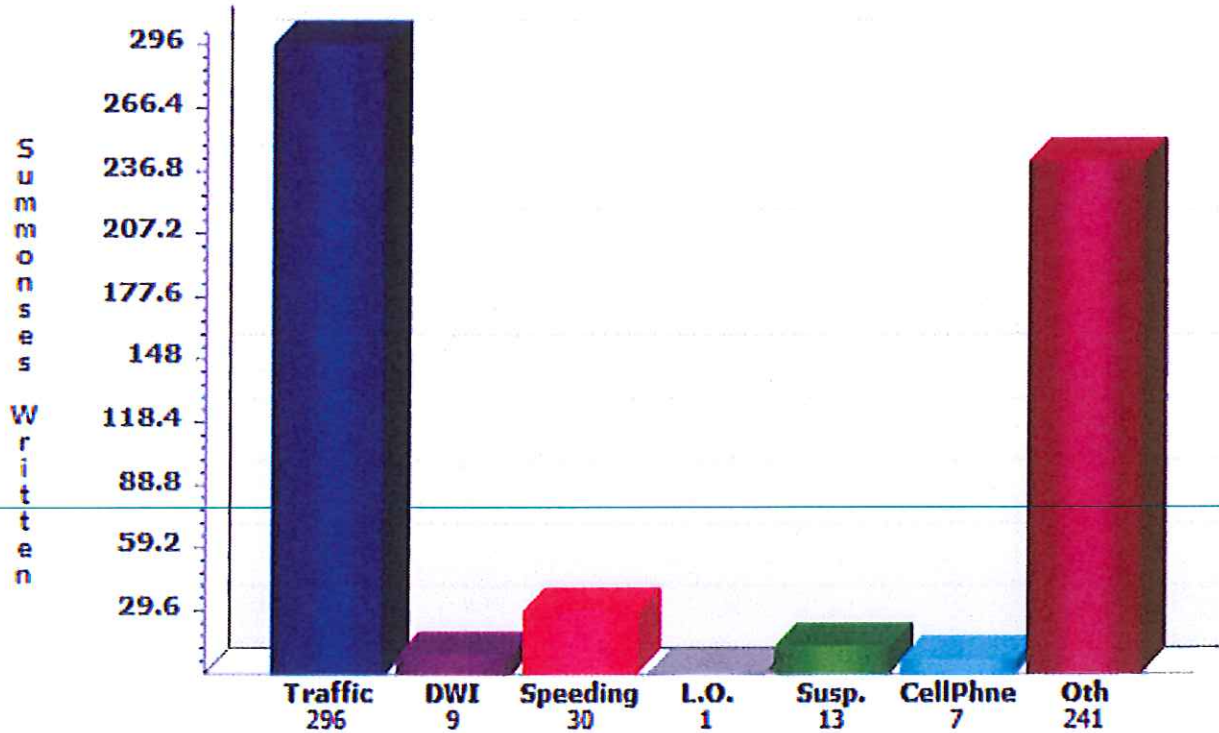
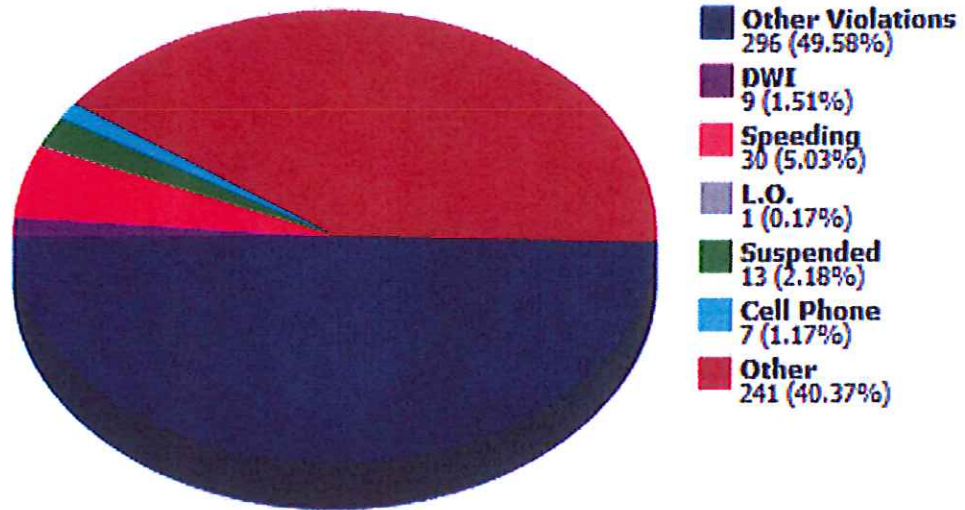

Summons Graphs for: April 2014



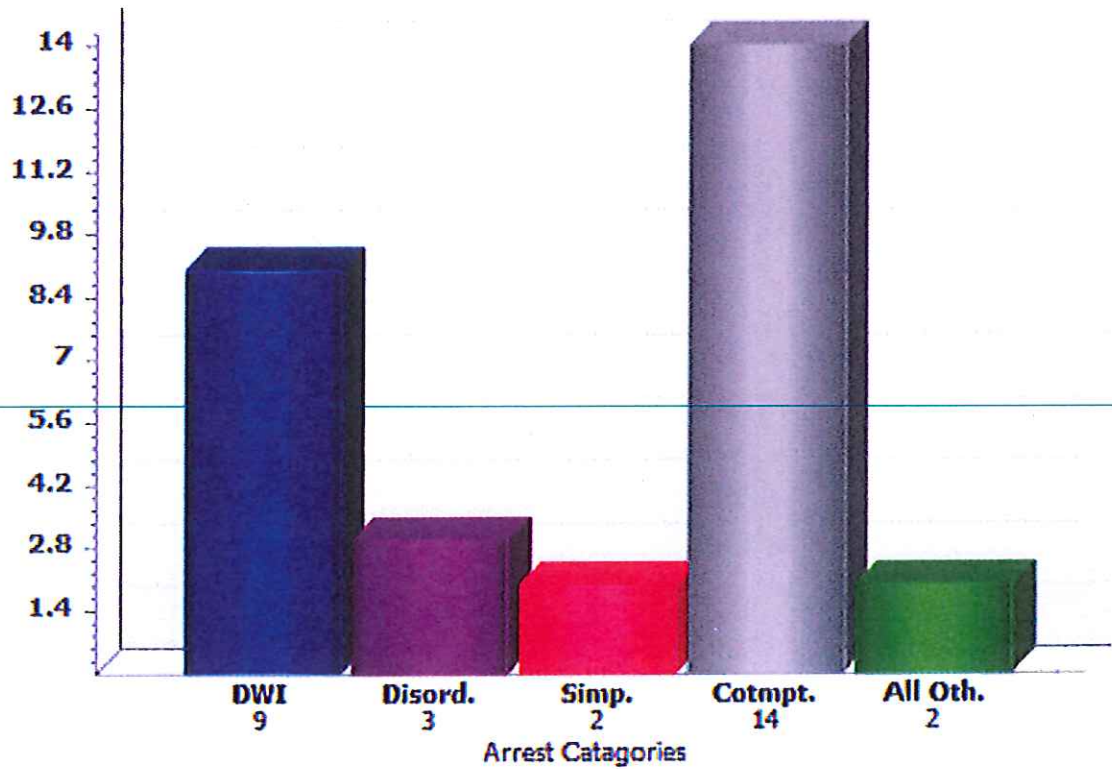
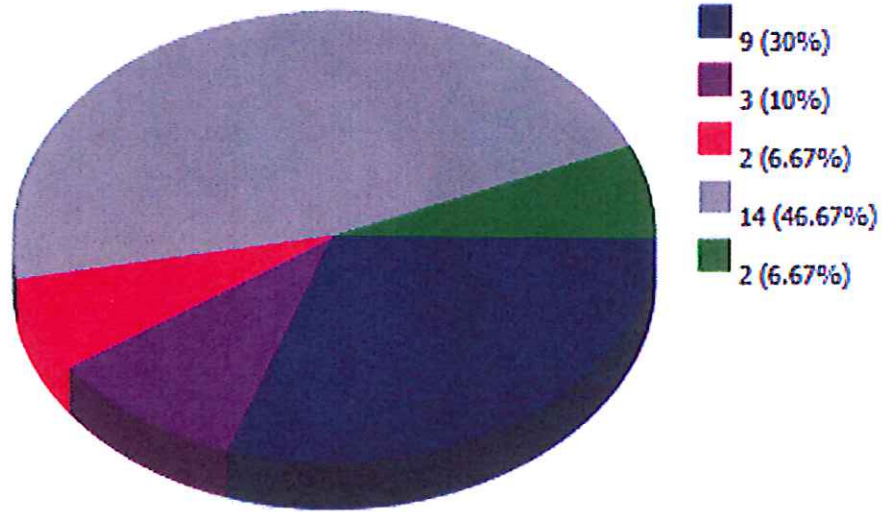
