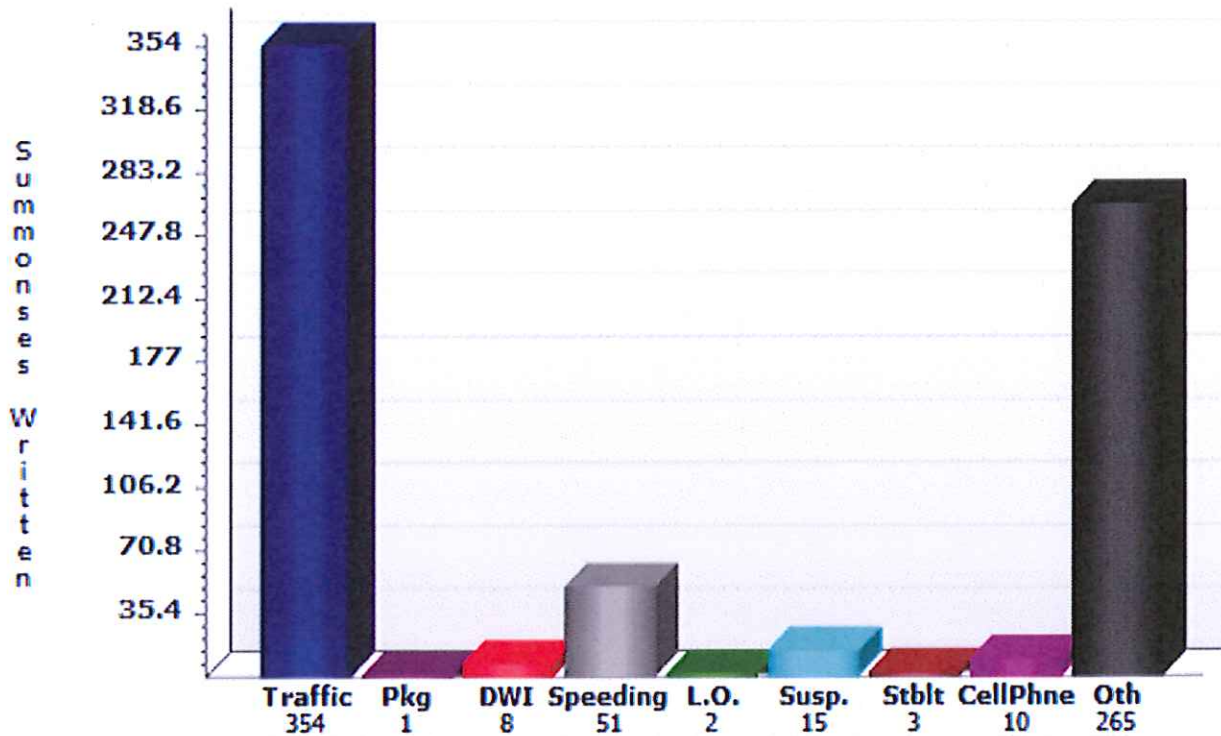
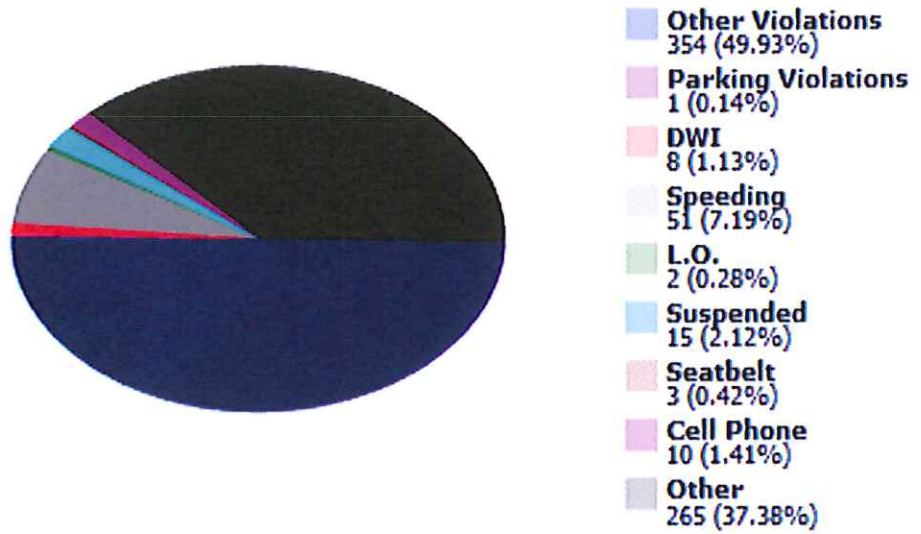

Summons Graphs for: May 2014



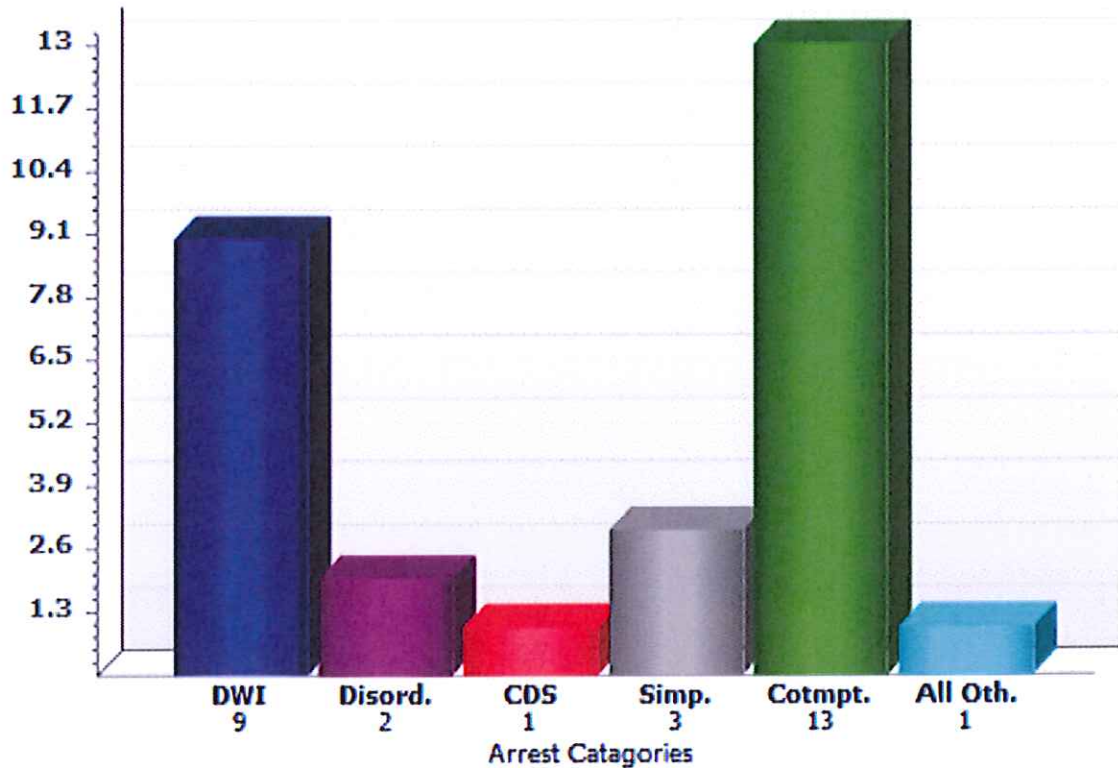
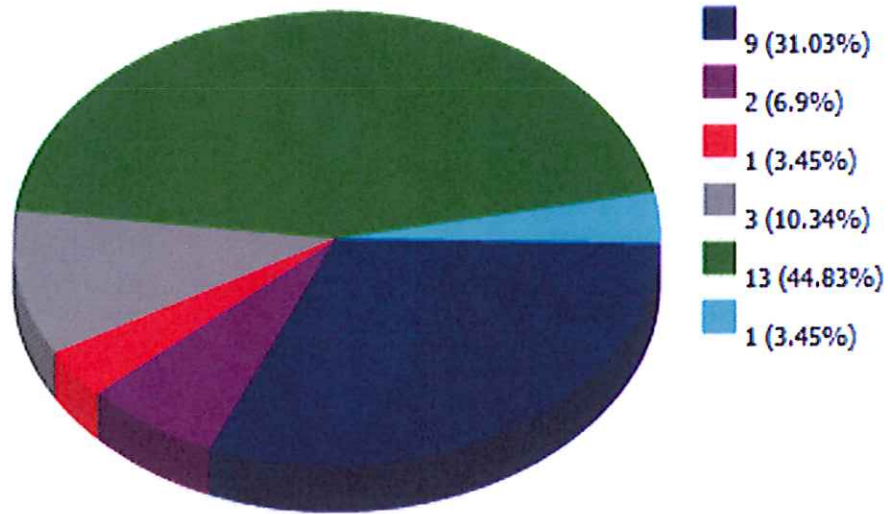
