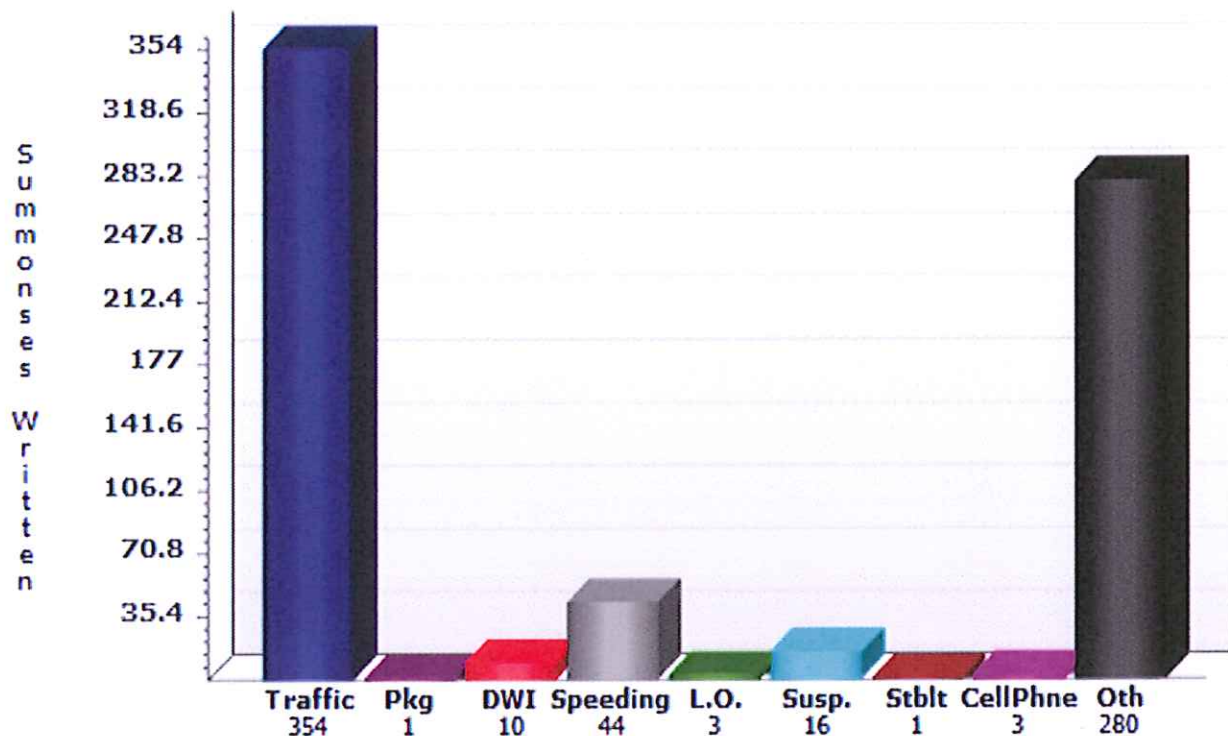
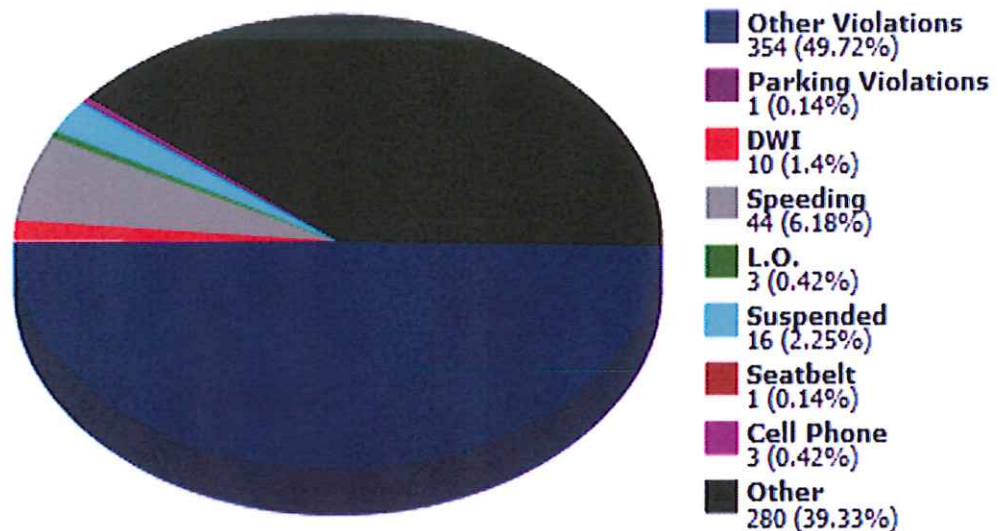

Summons Graphs for: June 2014



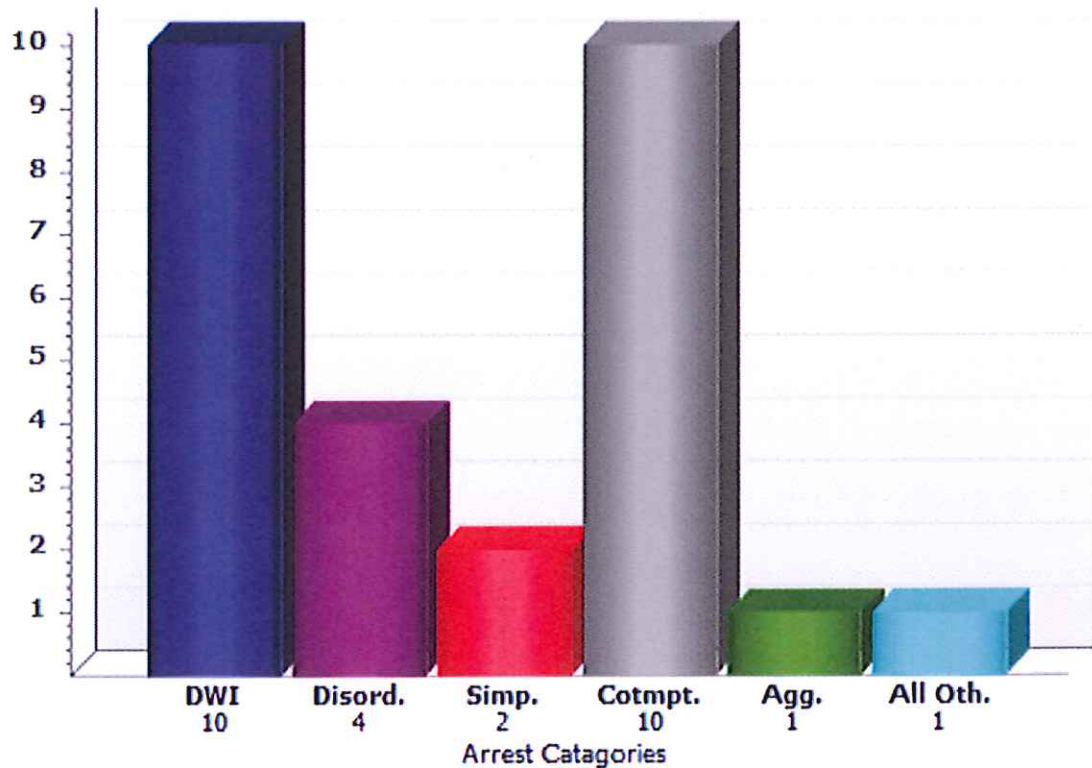
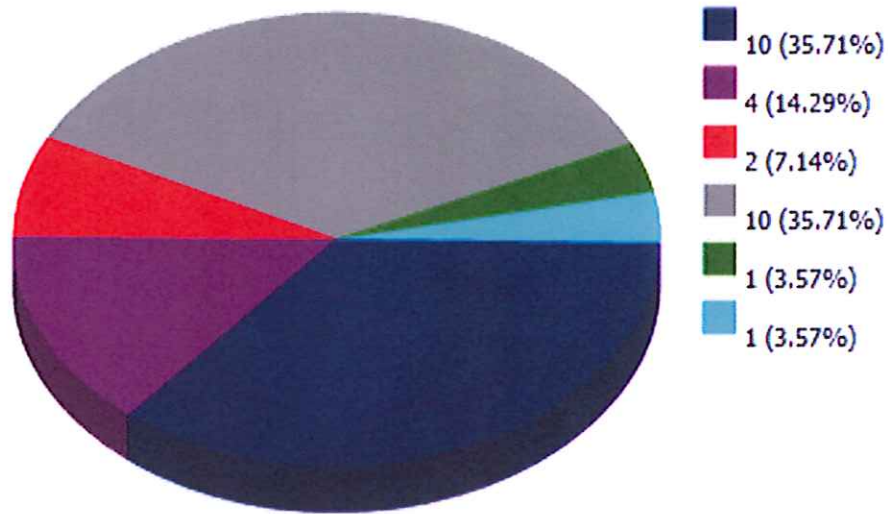
