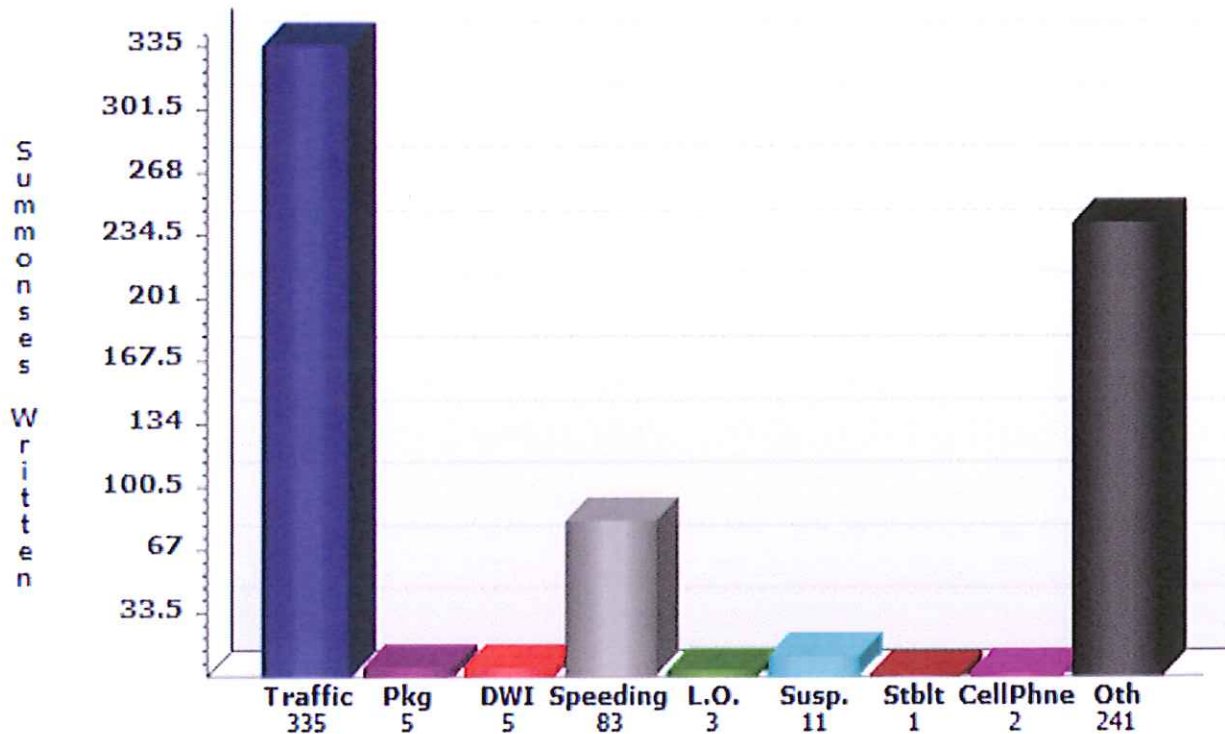
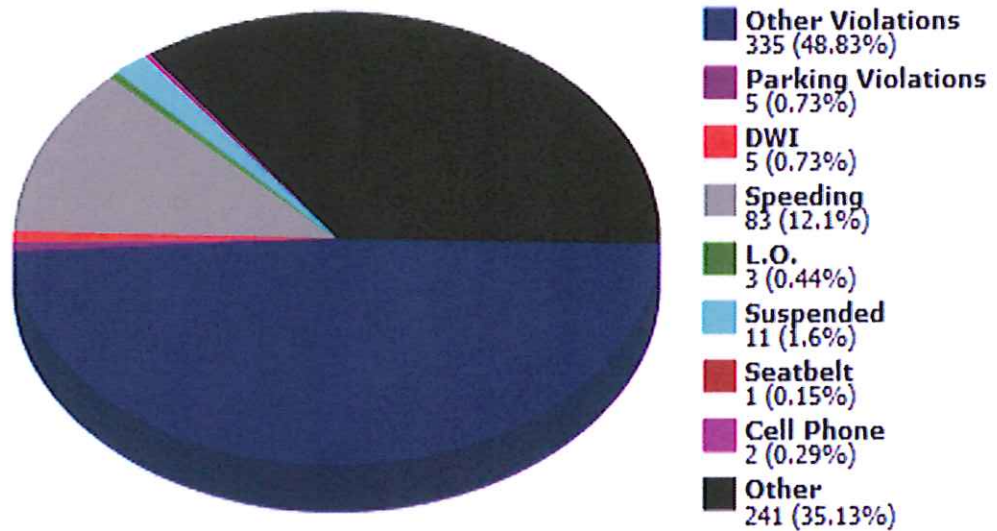

## Summons Graphs for: July 2014





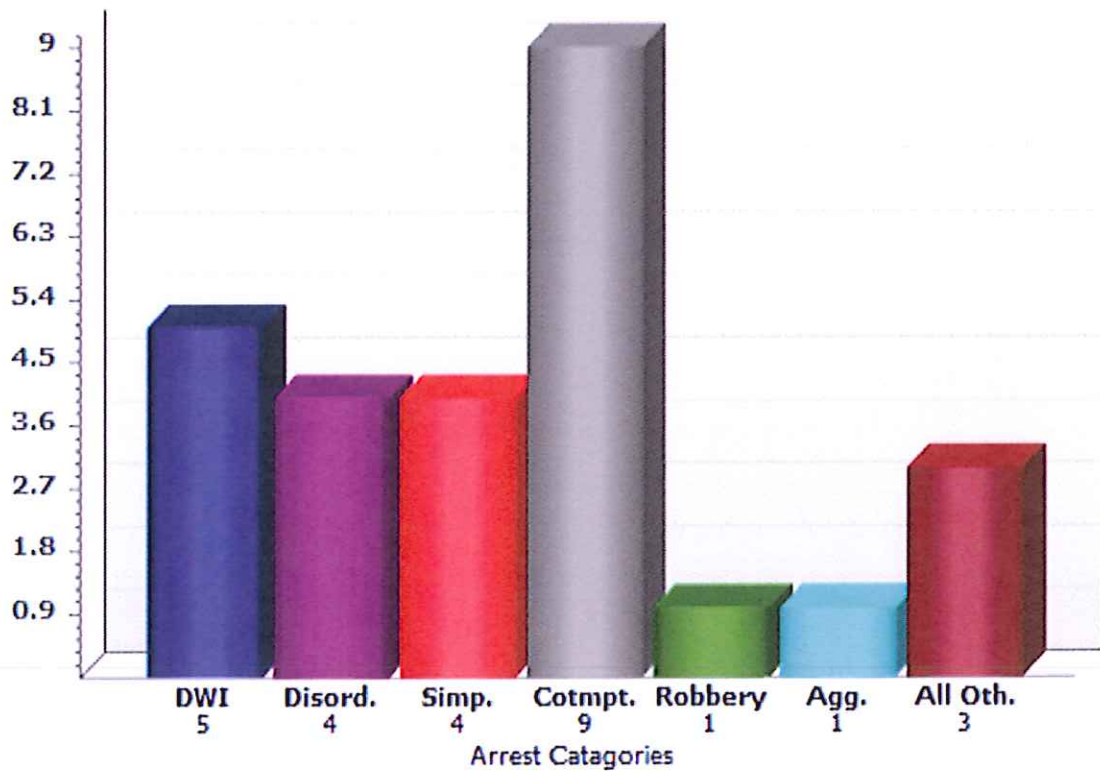
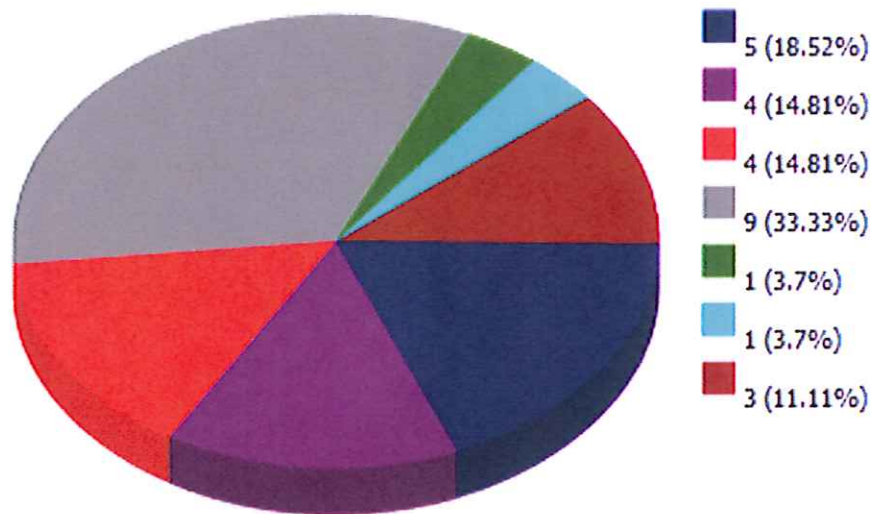
