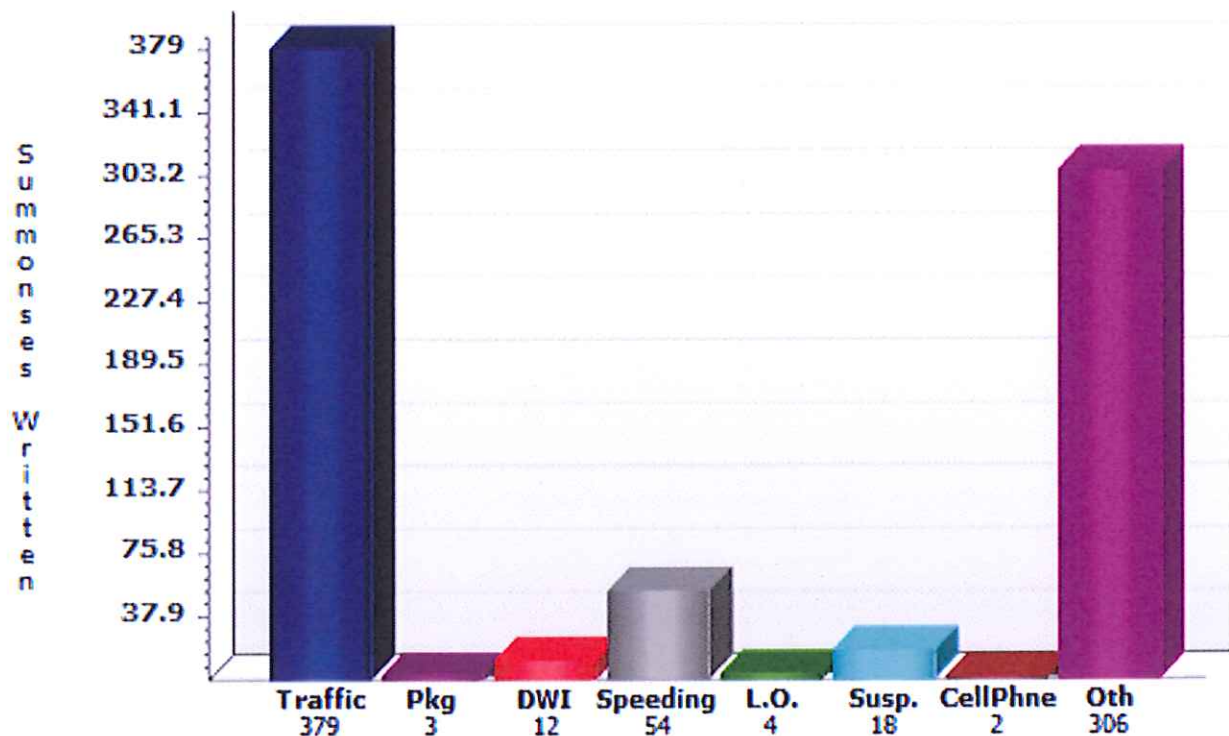
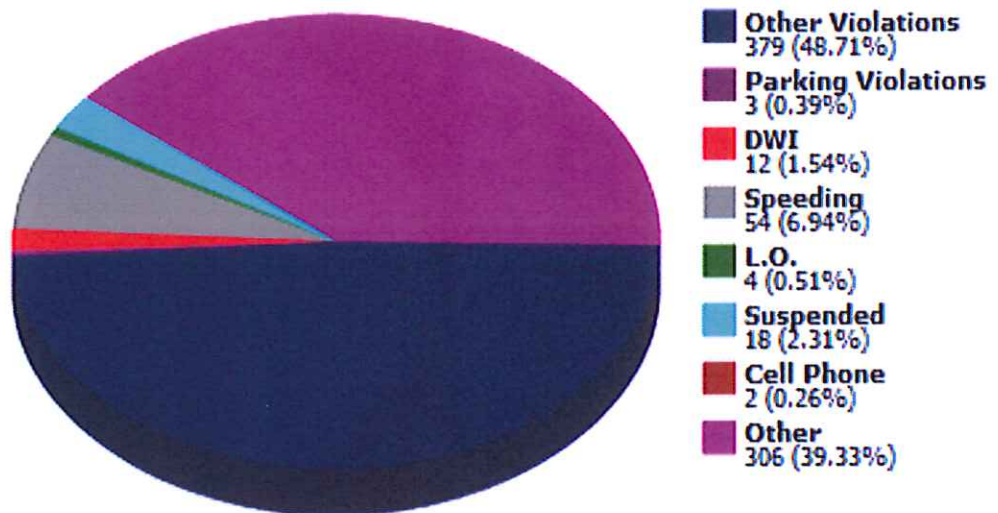

Summons Graphs for: August 2014



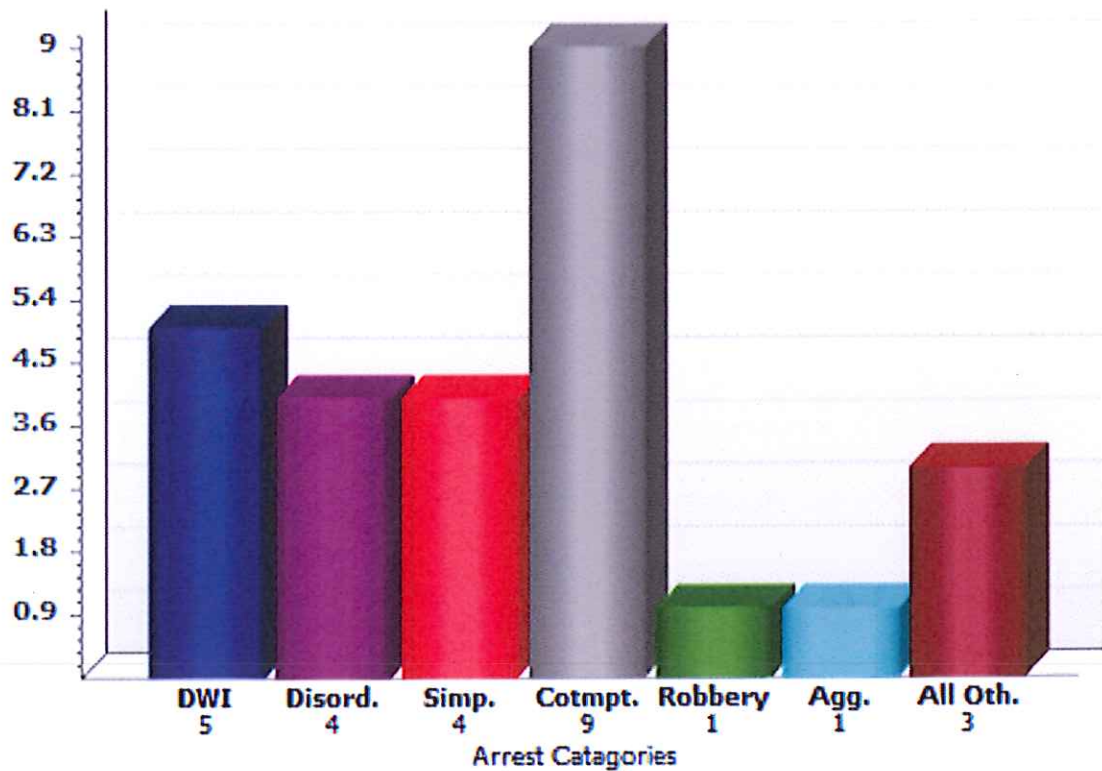
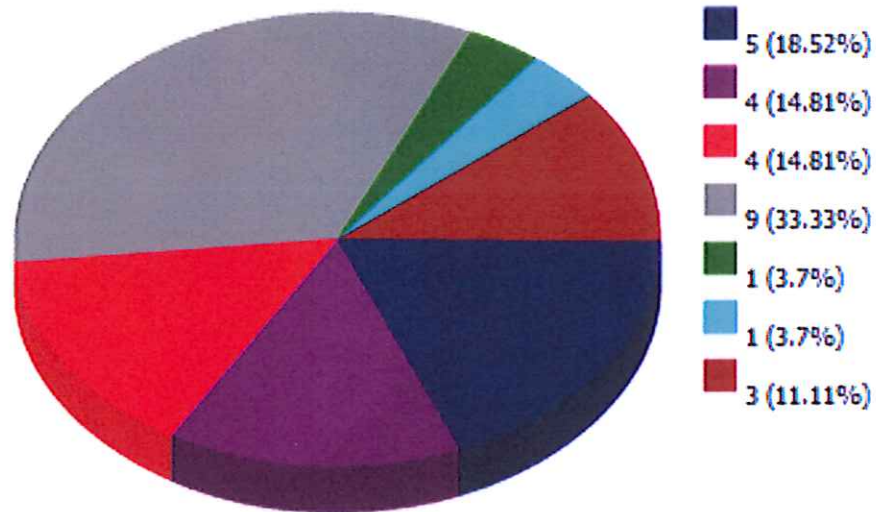
