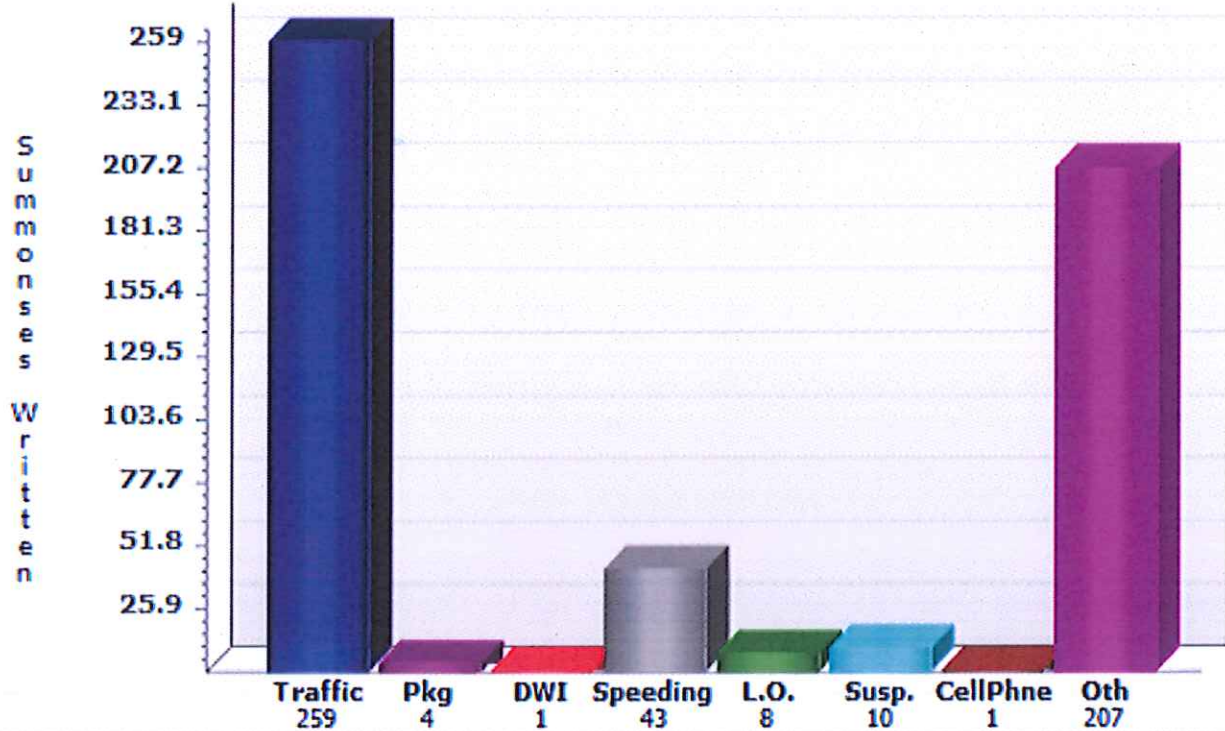
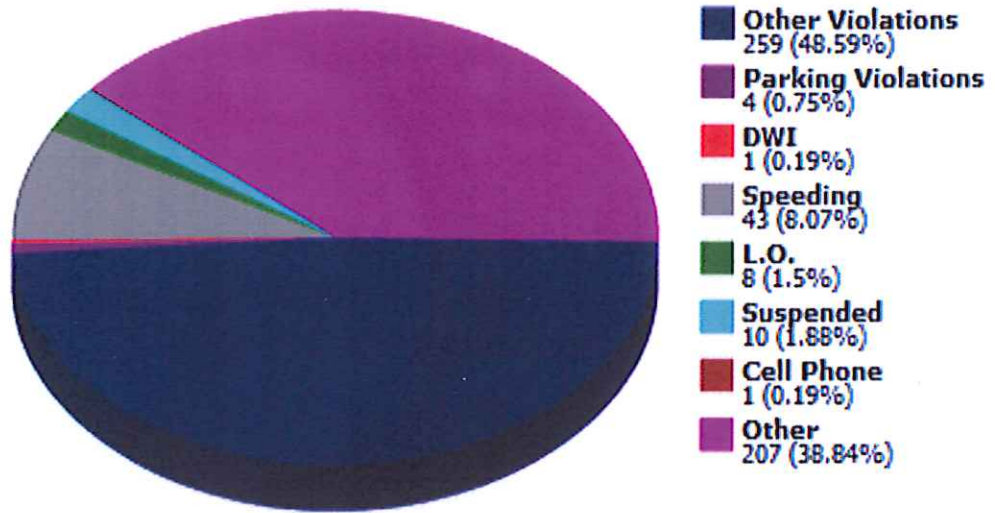

Summons Graphs for: February 2015



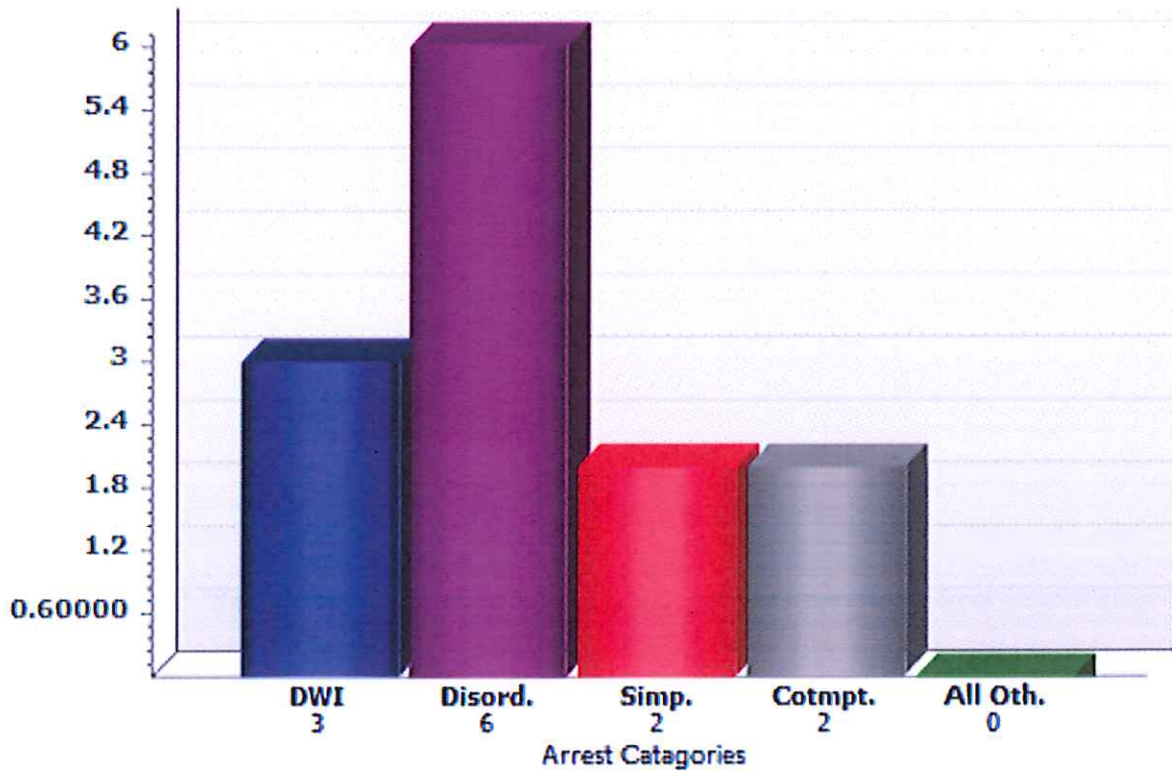
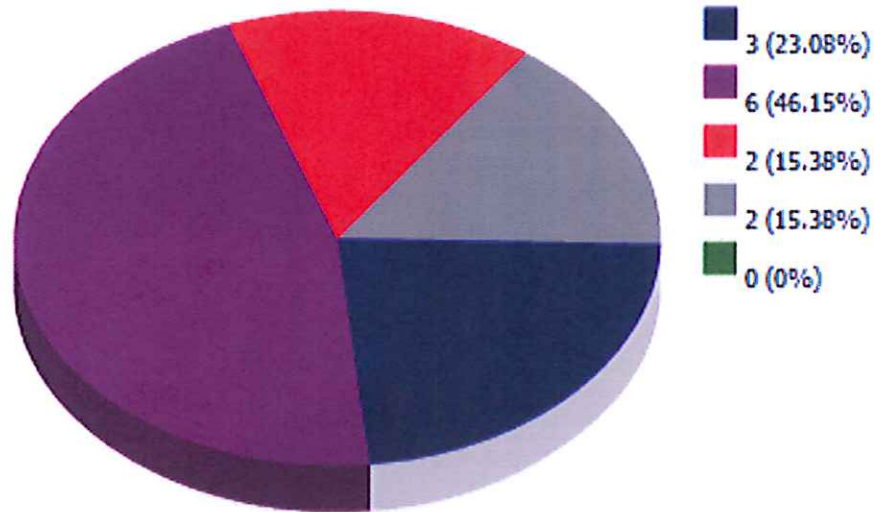

Arrest Graphs for: February 2015



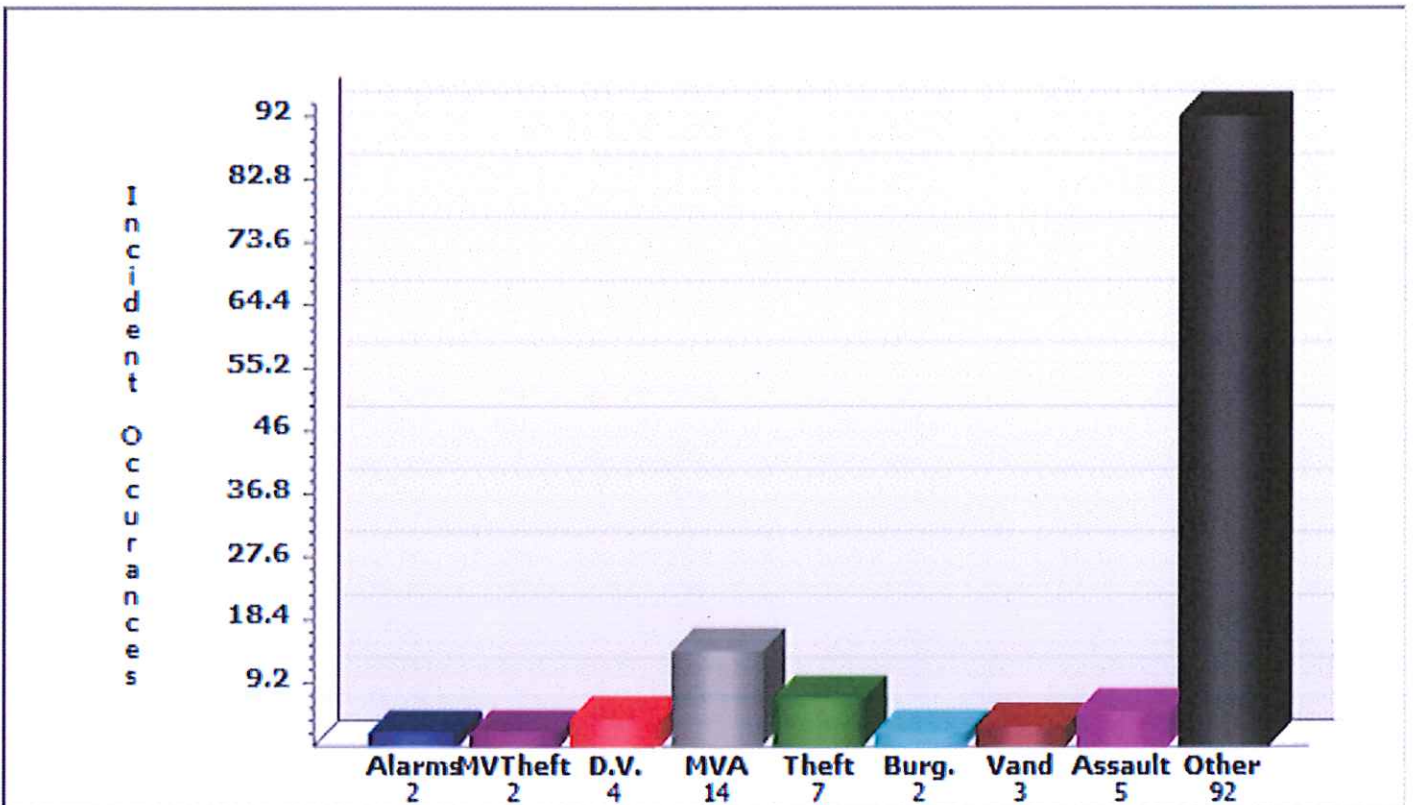
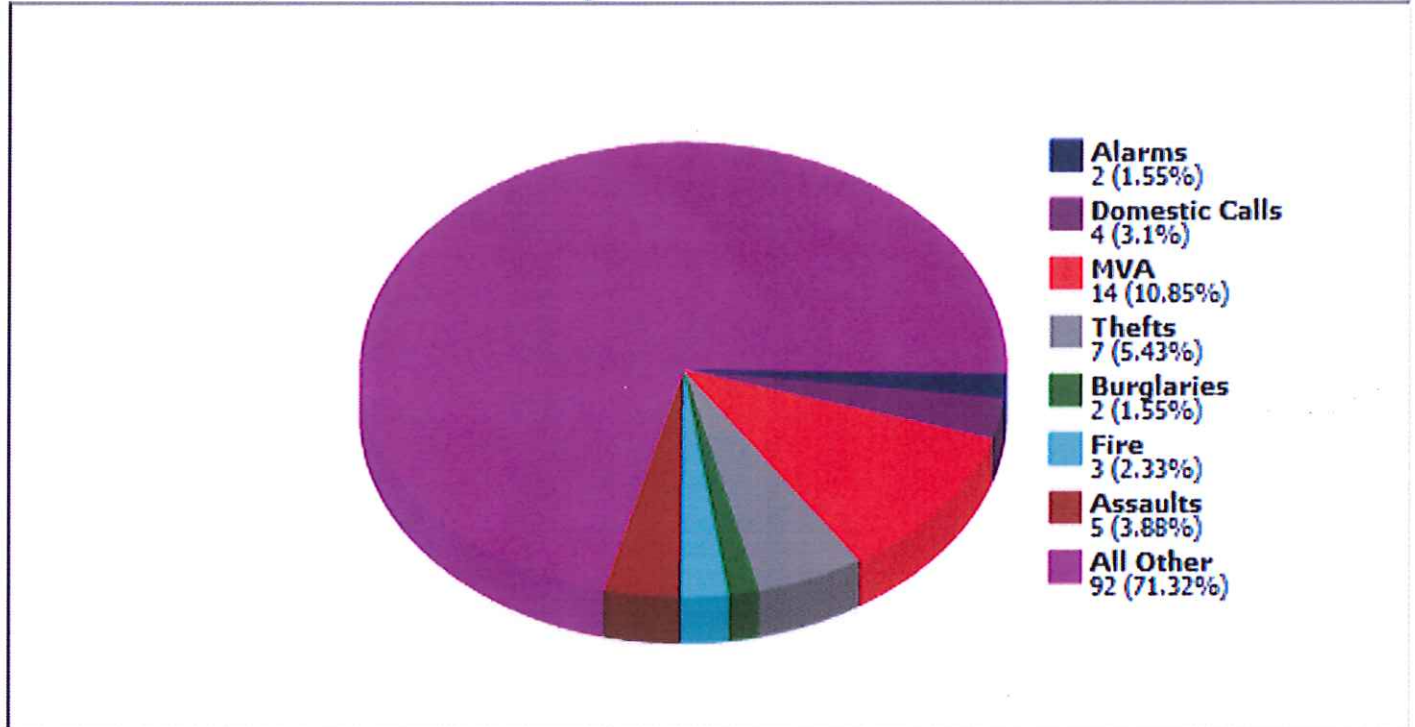
