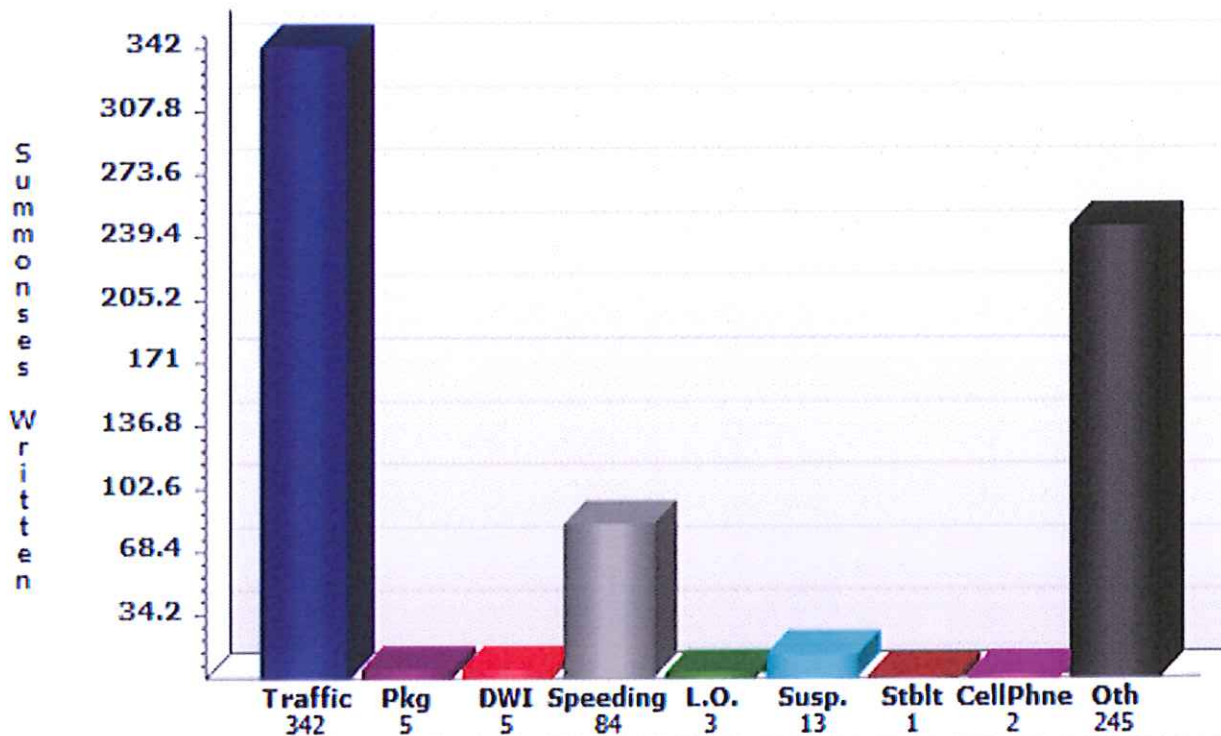
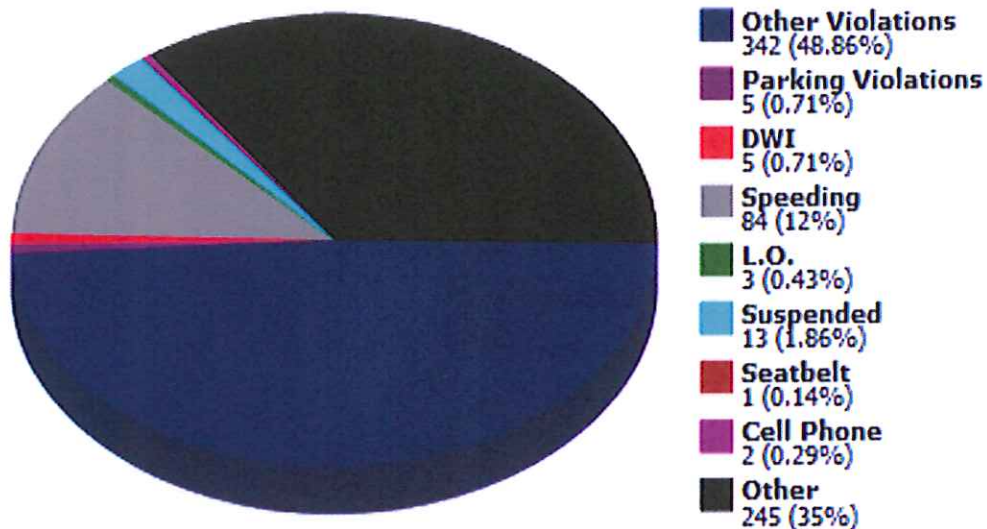

### Summons Graphs for: December 2014



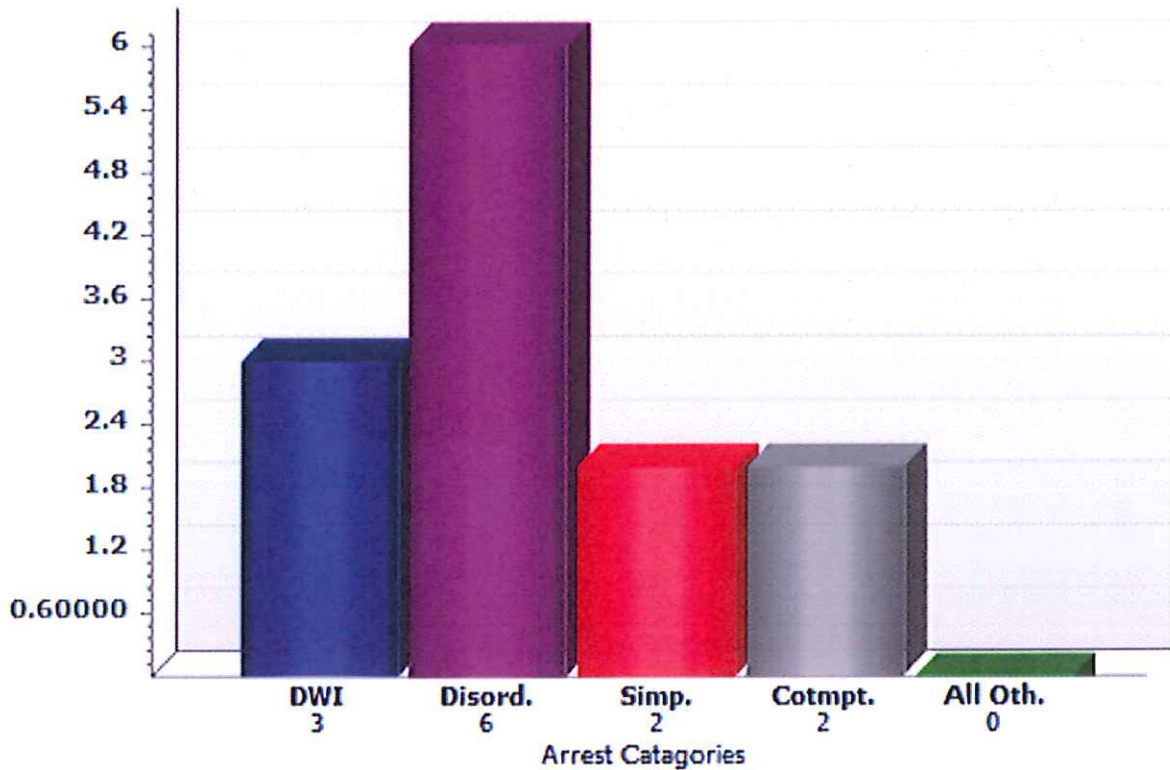
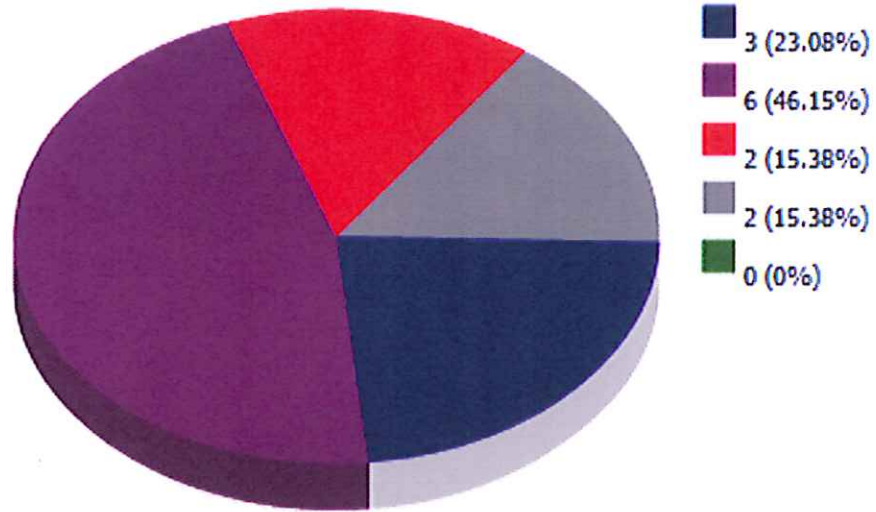
