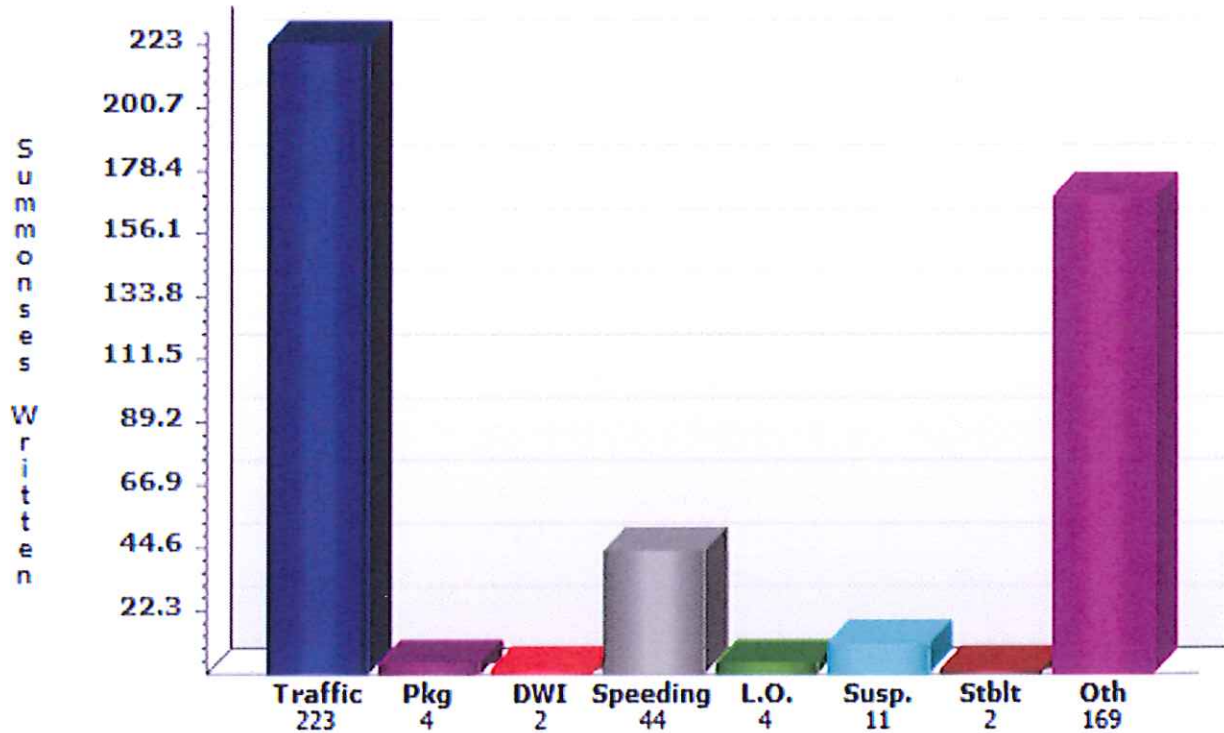
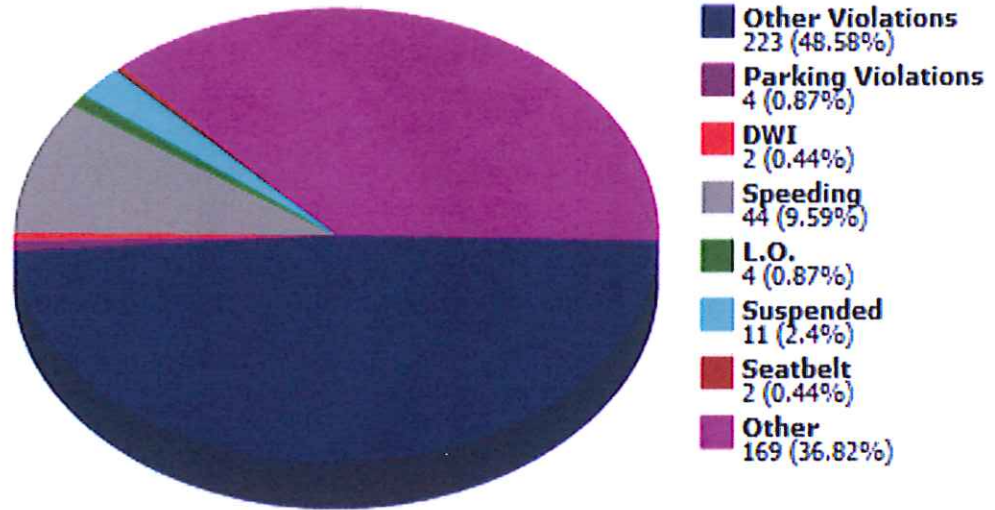

Summons Graphs for: September 2014



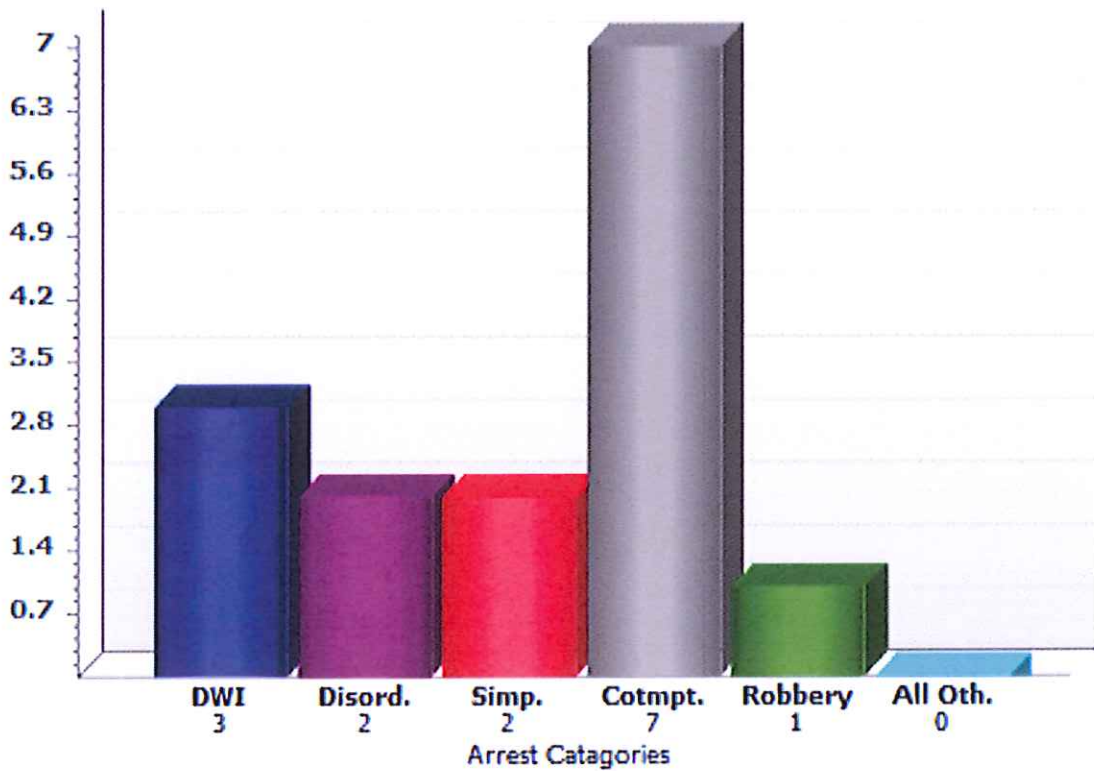
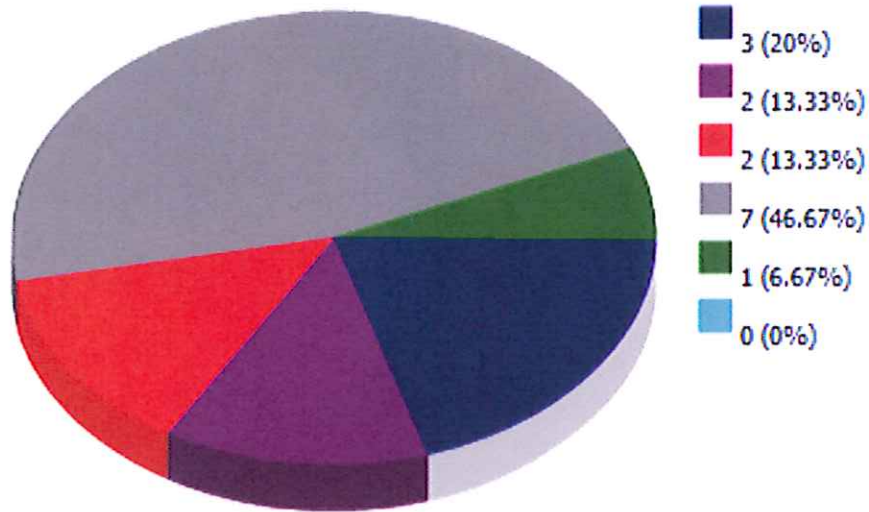
